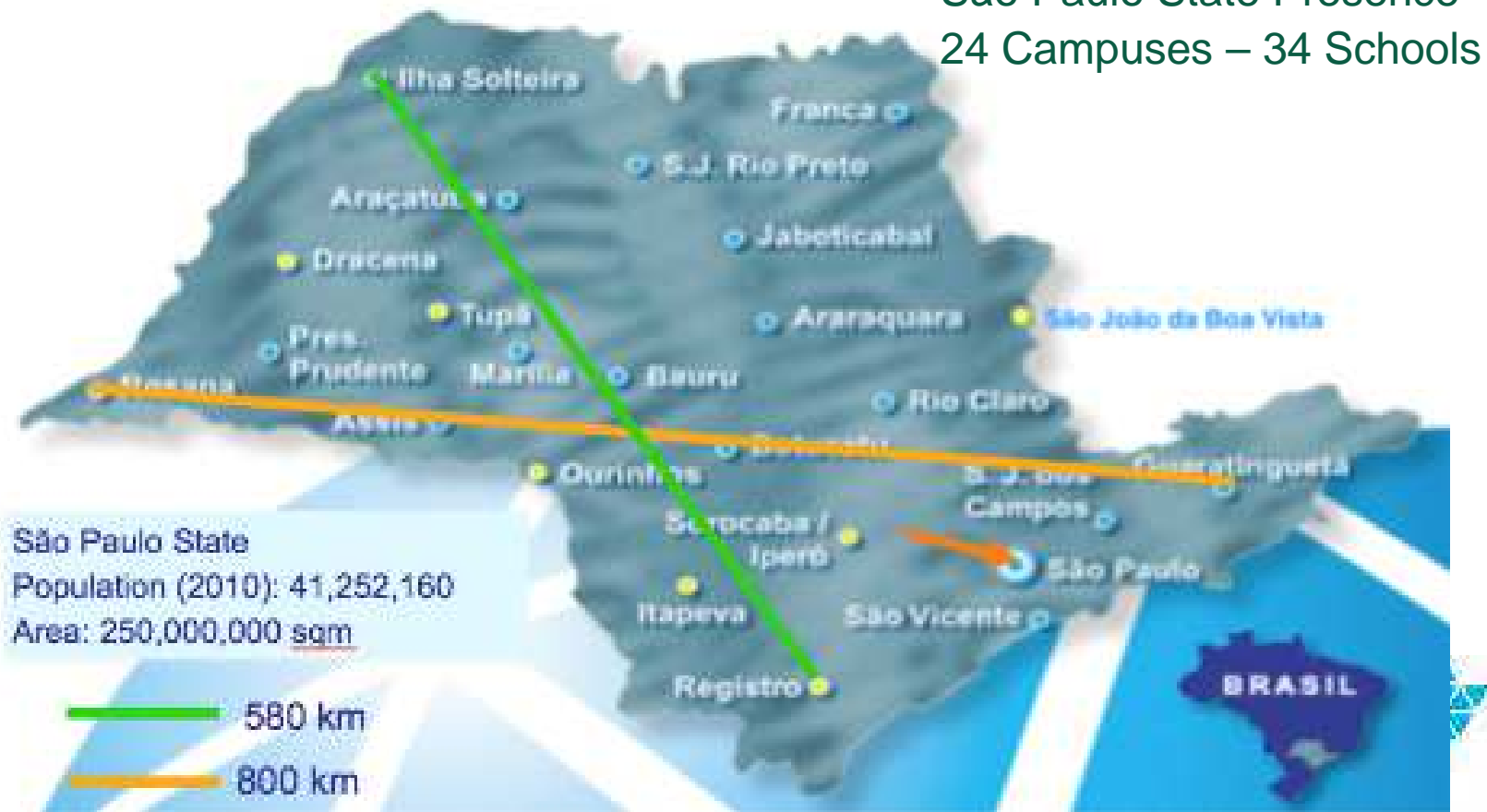

UNESP: Facts and Figures

- Undergraduate students: **36.000**
- **179** Undergraduate programs (2014)
